18 19 20	AN ACT to Establish the Cost of the 1983 Spruce Budworm Suppression Project.
21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
24 25 26 27	Whereas, prompt determination of the cost of the Spruce Budworm Spray Project is necessary in order to establish preproject taxes to be assessed on landowners in the spray program area; and
28 29 30 31 32 33	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 3 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §8426, sub-§2, as amended by PL 4 1981, c. 278, §7, is further amended to read:

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- 2. Authorization by Legislature. Following the recommendation made in accordance with subsection 1, the Legislature shall determine, not later than February 15th March 1st, the amount, if any, authorized for expenditure for any spray project in that calendar year, except for the 1983 project which shall be determined not later than March 20th. That excise tax shall be assessed and collected in accordance with section 8427, subsection 2.
- 16 3. <u>Post-project excise tax</u>. The post-project tax 17 for forest land owners within the district shall be 18 computed and assessed as follows.
 - A. The director shall determine the total amount of costs incurred or budgeted to be expended in connection with any spray project conducted during the then current calendar year.
 - B. The amount computed in paragraph A shall be reduced by the amount of any moneys received for that project from the Government of the United States.
 - C. Ninety percent of the amount computed under paragraph B shall be raised by a post-project spray tax, the per acre rate of which shall be calculated by dividing the sum to be so raised by the number of acres which actually received spray treatment, as determined by the director.
 - D. Ten percent of the amount computed under paragraph B shall be raised by a post-project shared tax, applicable to all taxable acres in the district, the per acre rate of which shall be calculated by dividing the sum to be raised by

- the number of acres within the district, as designated by the director.
- 3 director shall certify in writing to the 4 State Tax Assessor, by September the 5 shared post-project tax rates and the 6 post-project spray tax rate, together with the 7 number of acres within each ownership which are 8 subject to those taxes.
- 9 F. The amount of the post-project excise taxes payable by each landowner shall be reduced by the amount assessed upon that landowner on account of the pre-project excise tax payable for that calendar year.
- 14 G. The State Tax Assessor shall compute, assess
 15 and bill, by November 1st the amount of the
 16 post-project excise taxes payable by each land17 owner in accordance with this section.
- In the event that the amount so calculated results in a negative balance for any landowner, the State Tax Assessor shall refund to that landowner the amount of the balance in the form of a tax rebate. The rebate shall be made no later than February 28th of the year following the assessment date:
- Sec. 3. Spruce budworm spray project cost. In accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 8426, the Legislature determines the cost of the 1983 Spruce Budworm Spray Project is \$7,230,000.
- 28 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 29 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect 30 when approved.

- 33 1. Correct the project date from 1982 to 1983;
- 34 2. Change the date that the Legislature deter-35 mines the amount of funds authorized to be expended;
