7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1042, L.D. 1349,
8 "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitu-
9 tion of Maine to Provide that the State may Enact
10 Property Tax Exemptions Relating to Watercraft not
11 Subject to Fifty Percent Reimbursement."

12 Amend the resolution by striking out all of the
13 2nd and 3rd paragraphs after the title and inserting
14 in their place the following:

15 'Constitution, Art. IV, Pt. 3, §23, as enacted by
16 CR 1977, c. 5, is amended by adding at the end a new
17 paragraph to read:

18 This section shall allow, but not require, reim-
19 bursements for statutory property tax exemptions or
20 credits for watercraft.'

21 Further amend the resolution in the 2nd paragraph
22 from the end in the last line (page 2, line 37 in
23 L.D.) by striking out the figure "1986" and inserting
24 in its place the figure '1984'
