following:

'12 MRSA §6671, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

4-A. State parks. The commissioner shall con-  
sult with the Commissioner of Conservation in review  
of any municipal ordinance that affects intertidal  
areas located within state parks. The commissioner  
may not approve any ordinance that threatens any  
important resources or provides insufficient oppor-  
tunity for recreational shellfish harvesting within  
state parks.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides for review of municipal  
ordinances affecting clam flats located within state  
parks. The ordinances will be reviewed by the Com-  
missioner of Marine Resources and the Commissioner of  
Conservation. Municipal ordinances shall provide  
opportunity for recreational digging within parks and  
shall not threaten any important park resources.
