AN ACT to Permit Municipalities to
Regulate Shellfish Harvesting Within State
Park Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is amended to read:

2. Municipal program and ordinance. Any municipality may, by vote of its legislative body, adopt, amend or repeal a shellfish conservation ordinance regulating the taking of shellfish in any areas in the intertidal zone or coastal waters of the municipality, including any of these areas that lie within state park land, as provided by this section.
