COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1038,  
L.D. 1363, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Composition  
of the Marine Resources Advisory Council."

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,  
line 23 in L.D.) the appreviation and figure  
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in subsection 1, in the  
7th line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out  
the underlined word "Three" and inserting in its  
place the underlined word 'Eight'

Further amend the bill in subsection 1, in the  
9th, 10th and 11th lines (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in  
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and 3 of  
the members shall be selected from persons who engage  
in commercial fishing" and inserting in their place  
the underlined words 'and one of the members shall be  
selected from persons who represent recreational  
fishing interests'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end  
before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition clause. Persons serving on  
the Marine Resources Advisory Council, as of the  
effective date of this Act, shall serve the remainder  
of their terms. The first vacancy to occur after the  
effective date of this Act shall be filled by a  
member selected from persons who represent recrea-  
tional fishing interests.'
