17 AN ACT to Permit the Sale of Liquor  
18 After 11 a.m. on Certain Sundays.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 28 MRSA §4, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c. 576,  
23 §2, is further amended to read:

24 No liquor ~~shall~~ may be sold or delivered by any  
25 licensee by himself, clerk, servant or agent on any  
26 licensed premise between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m. and  
27 between 1 a.m. and 12 noon on Sundays; except that no  
28 liquor may be sold or delivered between 1 a.m. and 11  
29 a.m. on Easter Sunday, on the 2nd Sunday in May and  
30 on the 3rd Sunday in June. Except as hereinafter  
31 provided, no licensee ~~shall~~ may permit the consump-  
32 tion of liquors on his premises on Sunday or after 15  
33 minutes past the hours prohibited for sale thereof,  
34 except by bona fide guests in their rooms. Munici-

1 palities shall have the power to regulate the hours  
2 of operation of bottle clubs as defined in section 2  
3 between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on January 1st  
4 and between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m. on other days.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to permit the sale of  
7 liquor after 11 a.m. on Easter Sunday, Mothers Day  
8 and Fathers Day.
