**RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes
and Authorizing Expenditures of Piscataquis
County for the Year 1983.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Piscataquis County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1983 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore, be it

5 **Sec. 1. Piscataquis County; taxes apportioned.**

6 **Resolved:** That the following sum is hereby granted as
7 a tax on Piscataquis County to be apportioned,
8 assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of
9 paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as
10 authorized herein, and for other purposes of law, for
11 the calendar year 1983:

12 **1983 TAX**

16 **Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.**

17 **Resolved:** That the following sums, based on the
18 county budget filed in the office of the Secretary of
