SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 457, L.D. 1388,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Wood Measurement Law."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designat-  
ed "§2362-A." by striking out all of subsection 3  
and inserting in its place the following:


'3. Butt scale. Butt scale may be used for  
final payment for cutting, provided that the standard  
procedures as developed by the State Sealer of  
Weights and Measures are used and the volume table to  
which the measurements are applied reasonably repre-  
sents the volume of trees being cut on the operation.  
In cases of dispute, the state sealer shall check  
scale the disputed wood in such manner as he deter-  
mines fair to all parties, as provided for in the  
appeal procedure of this section.

Butt scale may only be used until October 14, 1985.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment stipulates that butt scale is  
allowed in transactions involving wood measurement  
until October 15, 1985.
