18 RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes
19 and Authorizing Expenditures of York
20 County for the Year 1983.

22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves
23 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
24 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
25 and

26 Whereas, York County has certain expenses and
27 liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

28 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the
29 year 1983 hereinafter mentioned be immediately
30 assessed in order to provide the required revenue for
31 the county; and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
33 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
34 the Constitution of Maine and require the following

1 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
2 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
3 therefore, be it

4 **Sec. 1. York County; taxes apportioned.**

5 **Resolved:** That the following sum is hereby granted
6 as a tax on York County to be apportioned, assessed,
7 collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts
8 and necessary expenses of the county as authorized
9 herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calen-
10 dar year 1983:

11 **1983 TAX**

15 **Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.**

16 **Resolved:** That the following sums, based on the
17 county budget filed in the office of the Secretary
18 of State, are authorized as General Fund expenditures

21 services, contractual services, commodities and capi-
