23 24	§18-A. Conflicts; state boards; commissions; commit- tees and agencies							
25 26 27 28	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, mem- bers of any state board, commission, committee or agency shall be eligible to contract with the State where the contracts are awarded consistent with							
29 30	normal bidding procedures of the Department of Finance and Administration. Members shall also be							
31	eligible to receive grants where grants are awarded							
32 33	consistent with normal state procedure. In no case may any member vote on the award of a contract or

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the law 6 7 concerning conflicts of interest for members of state 8 boards, commissions, committees or agencies. This 9 bill permits members to contract with the State as long as the contract was awarded under normal bidding 10 procedures, they did not vote on the contract 11 and they did not contract directly with the board, com-12 13 mission, committee or agency with which they are mem-14 bers.

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
