## STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft extends the period during which a person may keep an unregistered deer from 24 hours to 7 days if the person is staying at a temporary place of lodging, unless he leaves that place before 7 days. The extension applies only to a hunting trip in an unorganized township. Also, this new draft permits a person to leave an unregistered deer in the woods, if he notifies a warden of its location within 12 hours and states the reason therefor.
