18 AN ACT to Authorize Easements for the  
19 Purpose of Sewage Disposal and to Eliminate  
20 Undersized Rights-of-way on Certain Leased  
21 Lots Owned by the Town of Bridgton.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
24 follows:

25 PL 1981, c. 343, §2 is amended by adding at the  
26 end 2 new sentences to read:

27 Boundaries of existing leased lots may be expanded by  
28 the town to maximize compliance with the Maine State  
29 Plumbing Code, the dimensional requirements of the  
30 Bridgton Shoreland Zoning Ordinance and to eliminate  
31 undersized rights-of-way that separate several of the  
32 existing lots. The town may grant easements to the  
33 unleased portions of the parcel described in this  
34 section for the purpose of sewage disposal.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill authorizes easements for the purpose of  
sewage disposal and to eliminate undersized rights-  
of-way on certain leased lots owned by the Town of  
Bridgton.

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
