16 17	Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:
18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	'Sec. 3. Study required. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall recommend to the Legislature a program to control hazardous air pollutants in this State. This recommendation shall be submitted within 30 days of the convening of the Second Regular Session of the 111th Legislature. This program shall be designed so as to consider the recommendations of the Department of Human Services.'

27 28 29 30 31 32	This amendment clarifies the method of legis- lative adoption of proposed emission standards and gives the Department of Environmental Protection a broader chance to recommend a hazardous air pollution control program at the next regular session of the Legislature.
