Whereas, Acts of the Legis-13 14 lature do not become effective until 90 days 15 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 16 Whereas, some employers and insurance carriers 17 designate unrealistic and unreasonably large amounts as woods equipment allowances in order to reduce employees' average weekly wages; and 18 19 Whereas, this practice unfairly reduces an injured woodsman's workers' compensation benefits and 20 21 shifts an unfair burden to employers who accurately report actual wages and thus pay higher insurance 22 23 24 rates; and 25 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 26 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 27 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 28 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-29 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 30 therefore. ' 31 Further amend the Bill in paragraph A in the 9th 32 line from the end (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by insert-33 ing before the underlined word "contract" the under-34 lined word 'negotiated' 35 Further amend the Bill in paragraph A in the 8th

4 5	Further amend the Bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following:
6 7 8	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
9	STATEMENT OF FACT
10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill. In addition, it amends the provision on equipment allowances by making it clear that only negotiated contracts may set allowances differing from the allowances set by the Department of Labor. The original bill allowed any contract to vary the equipment allowance, rather than only contracts fairly bargained between equally knowledgeable parties. This amendment prevents an employer from taking advantage of an unsophisticated employee.
