7 HOUSE AMENDMENT " \hat{A} " to S.P. 470, L.D. 1434, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Reassign Responsibilities Within the 9 Department of Environmental Protection."

10 Amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all 11 of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the fol-12 lowing:

'4. Organization of department. The commis-13 14 sioner, subject to the approval of a majority of after consultation with the Board of Environmental 15 Protection, shall organize the department into the 16 bureaus, divisions, regional offices and other admin-17 18 istrative units that he deems necessary to fulfill the duties of the department and support the duties 19 of the Board of Environmental Protection. With the appreval of a majority of After consultation with the Board of Environmental Protection, he shall prescribe 20 21 22 the functions of the bureaus and other administrative 23 24 units to insure that the powers and duties of the 25 board are administered efficiently so that all license applications and other business of the depart-26 27 ment may be expeditiously completed in the public interest.' 28

Further amend the Bill in section 4 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'The Governor shall appoint one member to serve as chairman.'

33 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end 34 before the statement of fact the following:

35 'Sec. 17. Effective date. Section 4 of this Act 36 shall take effect on March 1, 1984.'
