24 3. Personnel. To appoint a full-time executive
25 secretary and ~~chief compliance officer~~ counsel to the
26 commission, not subject to the Personnel Law, and
27 determine their remuneration; and to appoint, subject
28 to the Personnel Law, other personnel including, but
29 not limited to, investigators, attorneys, compliance
