STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT to Restrict Reimbursement of
Mileage to Boards and Commissions to no More
than that received by State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §1541, sub-§13, ¶A is enacted to read:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency, as defined in section 8002, subsection 2, may not authorize reimbursement for travel by any person at a rate greater than the rate established in section 8 for state employees.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this new draft is to provide a definition for state agency and to establish a uniform mileage reimbursement rate for all persons associated with State Government.

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
