Amend the bill in section 13 in the last 3 lines (page 10, lines 19 to 21 in L.D.) by striking out the punctuation and words ", the shore of which is owned or leased by 2 or more persons, firms or other legal entities" and inserting in their place the following: '7 the shere of which is owned by 2 or more persons, firms or other legal entities'

Further amend the bill in section 20 in subsection 1 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 12, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "destination" the following underlined punctuation and words ', except to transport logs or pulpwood from islands to the mainland'

Further amend the bill in section 20 in the 2nd paragraph in the last line (page 13, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the figure "1976" the following underlined punctuation and words ', except to transport logs or pulpwood from islands to the mainland'

Further amend the bill in section 20 in the 3rd paragraph in the 6th and 7th lines (page 13, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation "products," the following underlined words and punctuation 'or to transport logs or pulp-3wood from islands to the mainland,'

Further amend the bill in section 21 in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 13, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation "products," the following words and punctuation 'or to transport logs or pulpwood from
