18 the Community Development Block Grant
19 Program to Include the Development

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 5 MRSA §3305, sub-§1, ¶I, as enacted by PL 1981,
25 c. 702, Pt. Y, subpt. 3, is amended to read:

26 I. Act as the public agency of the State for the
27 purpose of accepting and distributing state and
28 federal funds or other assistance in relation to
29 community and economic development. Federal Com-
30 munity Development Block Grant funds will be
31 expended in those nonentitlement areas and for
32 those projects duly authorized under the United
33 States Housing and Community Development Act of
34 1974, Title 1, and its subsequent amendments.
