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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to

S.P. 482,

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L.D. 1464, Bill, "AN ACT to Restructure Maine's

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Insurance Management Program."

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Amend the Bill in section 12 in that part designated "§1731." in the next to the last line (page 11, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting before the words "The fund" the following: 'The fund may be used for loss prevention programs, including materials, equipment and temporary employees. The amount used in loss prevention for one year may not exceed 5% of the fund as of July 1st of that fiscal year.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

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Any fiscal impact of this bill will be to a dedicated revenue account.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to fund loss prevention programs. A good loss prevention program will reduce losses and protect the fund. This program will pay for itself and more especially in reducing workers' compensation claims. This amendment will greatly help the safety team concept that has already been approved by executive order.

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At present there is no uniform safety program. This loss prevention program will unify safety programs in the State.

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
