HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1125, L.D. 1469, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Apprenticeship and Training Opportunities in State Government and to Assist Qualified Recipients of Aid to Families with Dependent Children to Compete for State Apprenticeships."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§636" in the first paragraph in the 4th line (page 2, line 1 in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word "apprenticeship" the underlined word 'registered'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§636" in the 3rd paragraph in the 5th line from the end (page 2, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word "state" the underlined word 'registered'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the fact that the bill applies to registered apprenticeship programs.
