20 for Certain Church Affiliated Residential

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§42 is enacted to read:

26 42. Certain church affiliated residential
27 homes. Sales to any church affiliated nonprofit
28 organization which operates, under a charter granted
29 by the Legislature, a residential home for adults.
