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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 497, L.D. 1503,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify, Simplify and Improve Cer-
tain Sections of the Labor Laws of Maine."

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Amend the bill in section 8 in the 6th and 7th
lines (page 5, lines 32 and 33 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "Maine Employment Security Unem-
ployment Insurance Commission," and inserting in its
place the following: 'Maine Employment Security Com-
mission,'

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Further amend the bill in section 8 in the 9th
line (page 5, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the
word "statute" the underlined words 'or Executive
Order'.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to make L.D.
1503 consistent with L.D. 978. This amendment
authorizes the Commissioner of Labor to be paid from
administrative funds of the Bureau of Employment
Security, the Bureau of Labor Standards and other
administrative funds which the commissioner is
authorized by statute or Executive Order to adminis-
ter. The Unemployment Insurance Commission is re-
