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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 501,

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L.D. 1513, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Return

9

and Proper Disposal of Pesticide Containers."

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Amend the bill in section 2 in that part desig-

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nated "§1471-Q." in subsection 5 by striking out all

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of the 2nd paragraph (page 3, lines 10 to 16 in L.D.)

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and inserting in its place the following:

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'After April 1, 1985, it shall be unlawful for any

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person to possess a limited or restricted pesticide

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container subject to this regulation without a prop-

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erly approved and affixed sticker, except pesticide

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dealers and distributors may hold containers if they

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are for sale and not for personal use.'

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part

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designated "§1471-Q." in subsection 6 in the 5th line

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(page 3, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the

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underlined word "pesticide" the following: 'or at a

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place otherwise established by regulation'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment takes into account situations

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where a dealer or distributor is also a farmer and it

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recognizes that dealers regularly deliver pesticides

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to the farmer on the farm.
