COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1145,
L.D. 1517, Bill, "AN ACT to Incorporate Bills Passed
in the Second Regular Session of the 110th Legis-
lature into Title 20-A."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Title 20-A takes effect on July 1, 1983,
which is less than 90 days after adjournment; and

Whereas, it is essential that the laws passed
last session are part of Title 20-A when it becomes
effective; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,'

Further amend the bill in section 13 in that part
designated "§2301." in the 5th line (page 9, line 24
in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word
"removal" and inserting in its place the underlined
word 'recall'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on
