SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 511, L.D. 1528,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Require Swimming Pools to be
9 Enclosed."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1634, by
11 striking out all of the last sentence and inserting
12 in its place the following:

13

'Municipalities may adopt and enforce swimming pool
14 enclosure ordinances, or enforce existing ordinances,
15 that are either less restrictive or more restrictive
16 than this chapter, or that concern matters not dealt
17 with by this chapter.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

19

Under the home rule provisions of the Revised
20 Statutes, Title 30, section 1917, this amendment will
21 allow municipalities to adopt and enforce pool enclo-
22 sure ordinances that are either less restrictive or
23 more restrictive than this statute. If a municipal-
24 ity has no ordinance, the state statute will apply,
25 but if a municipality currently has an ordinance, or
26 adopts one in the future, the municipal ordinance

1 will apply rather than the state statute. This dif-
2 fers from the original bill, which allowed municipal
3 ordinances to override state law only if they were as
4 stringent as the state law.
