24	§1825. Smoking in nursing homes
25 26 27	Residents, visitors and personnel in any nursing home licensed pursuant to this chapter may smoke only in specifically-designated areas of the nursing home.
28	STATEMENT OF FACT
29 30 31	The new draft simplifies the original bill, retaining only the first provision, but stating it positively rather than as a prohibition.

"Patients" are now more appropriately referred to as "residents." Smoking in nursing homes will take place only in specifically-designated areas, which could include patient rooms.

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
