18 19 20	AN ACT Relating to Attendants for Power Boilers.
21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 24	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §171, as amended by PL 1975, c. 771, §271, is further amended to read:
25	§171. Board of Boiler Rules
26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	The board of appeals, as heretofore established, shall be known as the "Board of Boiler Rules," and shall consist of 5 7 members, 4 6 of whom shall be appointed by the director, with the approval of the Governor. At the expiration of their respective terms of office their successors shall be appointed for terms of 4 years each. In the event of a vacancy by reason of the death or resignation of any of said 4 the appointed members, or otherwise, the director

1 shall fill such vacancy for the remainder of the term 2 with a representative of the same class. Of these 3 said 4 6 appointed members, 2 shall be representa-4 tives of labor within this State who are boiler 5 makers or have boiler licenses, one shall be a repre-6 sentative of the owners and users of steam boilers 7 within this State, one a representative of the boiler 8 manufacturers within this State, one a representative 9 of the operating steam engineers in this State and 10 one a representative of a boiler inspection and 11 insurance company licensed to do business within the 12 State. The 5th 7th member shall be the director, who shall be chairman of the board. The board shall meet 13 14 at least twice yearly at the State Capitol or other 15 place designated by the board.

Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §218 is enacted to read:

17 §218. Attendants for power boilers

The Board of Boiler Rules shall gather data in 18 19 order to determine if any rules on power boiler attendants are needed for safety purposes, and then 20 21 shall promulgate any rules necessary to ensure that 22 power boilers are checked by an attendant with the 23 frequency and method best suited to safeguard life, health and property. All rules shall be promulgated 24 pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, 25 Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II, by January 1, 26 27 1984, and a copy submitted to the Legislature for 28 review.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft adds 2 additional members to the Board of Boiler Rules. These 2 members representing labor must be boiler makers or have boiler licenses and will be appointed by the director, with the approval of the Governor, as are other appointed members of the board.

The new draft also adds a section to Title 26 authorizing the Board of Boiler Rules to gather data to determine if rules are needed and then to promulgate any rules it believes are necessary to ensure power boilers are checked by an attendant with the

frequency and method best suited to safeguard life, 1 health and property. All rules must be promulgated 2 3 under the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, by January 1, 1984, and a copy 4 sub-5 mitted to the Legislature for review. This approach allows the board to study available date on boiler 6 7 safety and consider numerous factors in its rules proposals, including the size and type of boilers 8 involved, their location and whether rules are even 9 10 necessary in certain cases.
