AN ACT to Prohibit Harassment of
Hunters, Trappers and Fishermen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA c. 710 is enacted to read:

CHAPTER 710

HARASSMENT OF HUNTERS, TRAPPERS

AND FISHERMEN

§7541. Harassment prohibited

1. Interference with taking. No person may willfully interfere with the lawful hunting, fishing or trapping of a wild animal, wild bird or fish.
