SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 545, L.D. 1590,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Comprehensive Marketing
Program for Maine Agricultural Products."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 5. 7 MRSA §1036, sub-§4, is enacted to
read:

4. Transfer of positions. The Commissioner of
Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources shall have the
authority to transfer 2 positions presently desig-
nated as consumer food inspectors from the Division
of Regulation to the Bureau of Agricultural Marketing
and to change the position titles to produce inspec-
tors. These produce inspectors are to serve as qual-
ity assurance field workers.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment gives the Commissioner of Agricul-
ture, Food and Rural Resources the authority to shift
inspection personnel to provide more effective cover-
age of field inspections of potatoes packed under the
Maine bag program.
