18 the Department of Inland Fisheries and
19 Wildlife Through an Increase in
20 License Fees.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§6, as amended by PL
25 1981, c. 644, §5, is further amended to read:

26 6. Residents in Armed Forces. A combination
27 fishing and hunting license shall be issued upon pay-
28 ment of \$5 ~~\$15~~, plus the issuing fee, to a Maine res-
29 ident on active duty in the Armed Forces of the
30 United States, his spouse and children. These persons
31 shall be issued all other licenses or permits at res-
32 ident fees. The license will be valid during the year
33 of issue.

26 I. Alien small game hunting license.....\$55
27 (Permits hunting of all species, except deer and
28 bear)

29 J. Alien big game hunting license.....\$110
30 (Permits hunting of all species, including deer
31 and bear)

32 K. Alien combination hunting and fishing license
33 \$150

18 C. Any resident who procures a 3-day 5-day li-
