18 19 20	AN ACT to Regulate the Season on Coyotes.
21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	12 MRSA §7108 is enacted to read:
24	§7108. Coyote hunting permit
25 26 27 28 29 30	1. Eligibility. Any person who possesses a valid hunting license is eligible to obtain a permit from the commissioner to hunt coyotes at night, except that no permit may be issued to any person who has been convicted of a violation of section 7406, subsection 5.
31 32 33	2. Issuance. The commissioner shall issue a permit to hunt covotes at night to eligible persons without any charge or fee.

- 3. Open season. Notwithstanding section 7406, subsection 5, there shall be an open season for hunting coyotes at night in all counties of the State from January 1st to February 28th. The commissioner may terminate this open season at any time in any area if, in his opinion, an immediate emergency action is necessary due to adverse weather conditions or illegal hunting activity.
- 9 4. Restrictions. The following restrictions
 10 apply during the open season for hunting coyotes at
 11 night.
- A. All hunting shall be limited to the hours between 1/2 hour after sunset and 9 p.m., and to the hours between 4 a.m. and 1/2 hour before sunrise.
- 16 B. All hunting shall be limited to the use of shotguns only.
- 18 <u>C. All hunting shall be limited to areas where</u> 19 <u>the ground is completely covered with snow and to</u> 20 <u>ice covered bodies of water.</u>
- 21 <u>D. No person may hunt coyotes at night within</u> 22 100 yards of any motor driven vehicle.
- 23 E. Any person hunting coyotes at night shall be 24 in possession of an electronic, hand-held or 25 mouth-operated predator calling device.
- 5. Revocation. Any hunting license of a person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this section shall be revoked and he shall not be eligible to obtain any hunting license for a period of one year from the date of conviction.
- 31 6. Repeal. This section is repealed on April 1, 32 1986.

33 STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft provides for an open season on coyotes for night hunting during the hours specified in Title 12, section 7108, subsection 4. Hunting is limited by the use of shotguns on snow or ice covered areas, at least 100 yards from any motor driven vehicle. The conviction of a violation of the section results in a revocation of licenses to hunt for a period of one year.
