Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§1151-A." in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "purchase" the underlined words 'for the State'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§1151-A." in subsection 1, paragraph E in the first line (page 2, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "expenses" the underlined words 'of the Maine State Retirement System'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§1151-A." in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 3, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined words "District Court" the following: 'Judges of the Administrative Court'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§1151-A." in subsection 3, paragraph D in the 7th line (page 5, line 1 in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word "students" the underlined word 'unmarried'

'The reduction on retirement at the rate of 15% a year of the average amount of insurance for the last 3 years prior to retirement shall not apply to any Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court or

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 556, L.D. 1622

1 Superior Court, or to any Judge of the District
2 Court or Administrative Court nor to any retired
3 justice or judge who was insured and who is
4 living on September 14, 1979. The average amount
5 of insurance referred to in this paragraph for
6 any justice or judge shall be continued in force
7 at no cost to the justice or judge until 70 years
8 of age. At the age of 70 years, the amount of
9 insurance in force will become 25% of the average
10 amount of insurance.'
