7 8 9	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 557, L.D. 1623, Bill, "AN ACT to Define Connection under the Liquor Laws."
10 11	Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:
12 13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16	Whereas, a business proprietor holding a liquor license for his retail store to sell malt liquor or
17 18	table wine for off-premises consumption may wish to expand his business by obtaining a Class A restaurant
19 20	liquor license for a separate portion of his prem- ises; and
21 22	Whereas, this will improve the business climate and provide more jobs; and
23 24	Whereas, proprietors desirous of so expanding their businesses will benefit by immediate expansion
25 26	in order to service the upcoming summer tourist trade; and
27 28	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
29 30	the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
31 32	vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
33 34	Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§7." in the 2nd paragraph, 6th line (page 2, line 1
35 36	in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word "for" the following: 'to the same licensee'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated 1 "§7." in the 3rd paragraph by striking out all of the 2 first underlined sentence and inserting in its place 3 the following: 'There may be access between the 2 li-4 cense areas by the licensee or his employees if it is through areas open only to the licensee or his 5 6 7 employees. There shall be complete nonaccess between 8 the 2 license areas by the public.

9 Further amend the Bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following: 10

11 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.' 12 13

STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This amendment makes it clear that if a propri-16 etor obtains both a retail store liquor license and a 17 Class A restaurant liquor license, the public shall 18 not be allowed access between the 2 license areas. 19 There may be access between the areas by the licensee 20 or his employees if it is only through areas open only to the licensee or the employees such as a 21 kitchen or food preparation area. This would allow a 22 proprietor to use a common kitchen or storage area to 23 serve both licensed facilities, while avoiding 24 the 25 problems of customers circulating between the areas. The amendment also adds an emergency provision to 26 27 allow businesses to take advantage of the increased 28 summer tourist trade.
