COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 562,
L.D. 1625, Bill, "AN ACT to Effect Changes in the
Statutes of Various Occupational and Professional
Licensing Boards."

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 5
and 6 (page 3, lines 5 to 20 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 27 (page 11 lines 41 and 42, and page 12
lines 1 to 5 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the
following:

'Sec. 27. 32 MRSA §9607, first ¶, as amended by
PL 1983, c. 204, §15, is further amended to read:

Every commercial driver education school shall be
assessed for the actual expenses incurred by the
board or its agents for inspections, special investi-
gations or enforcement activities undertaken under
this chapter.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

Any fiscal impact of this bill will be Dedicated
Revenue accounts.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes 2 provisions relating to

1 the State Board of Funeral Service. The effect of
2 those provisions would have been to require licensure
3 by the board of a number of people and organizations
4 currently not subject to board control. As written,
5 it was perceived that the provisions would have
6 reversed long-standing legislative policies concern-
7 ing the regulatory power of funeral directors over
8 providers of related services and individual author-
9 ized persons.

10 This amendment also corrects section 27 to
11 reflect the passage of Public Law 1983, chapter 204.
