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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 563, L.D. 1637,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Workers' Compensation Cover-
age to Emergency Medical Services' Persons."

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Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause the abbrevi-
ation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

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'Sec. 2. 39 MRSA §22, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

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8. Premiums for volunteer emergency medical ser-
vices' persons. The workers' compensation insurance
premium charged an employer for coverage of its
employees who are volunteer emergency medical ser-
vices' persons, as defined in Title 32, section 83,
subsection 12, shall be based on an annual payroll of
not more than \$10,000.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that
ambulance and emergency care services staffed by
volunteer emergency medical services' persons are not
hindered in their role of providing moderately priced
emergency care by high workers' compensation insur-
ance rates. An employer will pay an insurance pre-

1 mium based on a maximum annual payroll of \$10,000 for
2 all its employees who are volunteer emergency medical
3 services' persons.
