COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1234,  
L.D. 1641, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the  
Lucerne-in-Maine Village Corporation Charter."

Amend the Bill in section 3 in section 5-A in the  
4th paragraph , 2nd line (page 4, line 4 in L.D.) by  
striking out the underlined word "raised" and insert-  
ing in its place the underlined word 'collected'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in section  
7-A in the 5th paragraph, 2nd line (page 6, line 32  
in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "non-  
resident voters" and inserting in their place the  
words 'a nonresident voter' and in the 5th line (page  
6, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined  
words "resident voters" and inserting in their place  
the words 'a resident voter'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of  
section 11 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 11. Referendum. The overseers of  
Lucerne-in-Maine and the selectmen of the Town of  
Dedham shall submit this Act to the legal voters  
within their respective territory at a regular or  
special meeting to be held within one year after pas-  
sage of this Act. This Act shall be approved by a  
majority of the legal voters of Lucerne-in-Maine  
voting at the election and a majority of the legal  
voters of the Town of Dedham voting at the election.  
If either a majority of the voters voting in  
Lucerne-in-Maine or a majority of the voters voting  
in the Town of Dedham do not approve this Act, it  
shall not be approved.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the  
emergency clause and inserting in its place the fol-

1     lowing:

2     'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
3     cited in the preamble, section 11 of this Act shall  
4     take effect immediately. Sections 1 to 10 of this Act  
5     shall take effect upon approval by a majority of the  
6     legal voters as provided in section 11.'

7                                   STATEMENT OF FACT

8             This amendment makes some changes in the printed  
9     version of the bill and requires the voters of  
10    Lucerne-in-Maine and the Town of Dedham to both  
11    approve this Act by majority vote before it becomes  
12    effective.

13            The provision to allow Dedham to repeal the Act  
14    has been deleted from the bill.
