11	This amendment makes the following changes.
12 13 14 15 16	(1) The criteria concerning "special circumstances" is deleted from the bill. The court is allowed to award attorney's fees and other expenses against the State if the state's position "was not substantially justified in fact and in law."
17 18 19	(2) The exemption list is broadened to include the denial or revocation of a license as well as the granting or renewal of a license.
20 21 22 23	(3) The exemption concerning eligibility or entitlement to a monetary benefit or its equivalent is removed. This exemption does not exist in the equivalent federal law.
24 25 26	(4) A new subsection 5 is added to require an annual report by the Attorney General on the number and amount of awards made against the State.
27 28 29	(5) A new provision is added in subsection 6 to prevent the applicability of this program to class actions.
30 31	(6) A sunset provision is added as of July 1, 1988.
