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SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1261, L.D. 1671,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Standards of Accessibility  
for Handicapped Persons in Public Housing and Places  
of Public Accommodation."

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Amend the Bill in section 3 in the 3rd line (page  
3, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the words "a new  
paragraph to read" and inserting in their place the  
words 'the following'

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Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking  
out all of paragraphs A to D and inserting in their  
place the following:

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'1. Accessible route. 4.3 accessible route;

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2. Doors. 4.13 doors;

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3. Adaptable bathrooms. 4.34.5 adaptable bath-  
rooms; and

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4. Tactile warnings. 4.29.3 tactile warnings on  
doors to hazardous areas.'


