HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1276, L.D. 1692, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Development of a Centralized Coordinated Planning and Evaluation Process for State Alcohol and Drug Abuse Activities."

Amend the Bill in section 14 in that part designated "§7110." in subsection 6 in the last line (page 13, line 23 in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation "reports;" the underlined word 'and'

Further amend the Bill in section 14 in that part designated "§7110." in subsection 7 the last line (page 13, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "; and" and inserting in its place the following: '.'

Further amend the Bill in section 14 in that part designated "§7110." by striking out all of subsection 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'8- Administer in accordance with current fiscal and accounting regulations of the State, and in accordance with the philosophy, objectives and authority of this Act, any funds appropriated for expenditure by the council or any grants or gifts which may become available, accepted and received by the council, and make, to be included in the annual report of the office, an annual report to the director, commissioner, Governor and Legislature not later than September 1st of each year concerning its work, recommendations and interests of the previous fiscal year and future plans, and shall make such interim reports as it deems advisable.
