    - 3. Distribute the form contract to any artist or the heir of any artist and the contracting agency participating in the acquisition of works of art under the Percent for Art Act, Revised Statutes, Title 27, chapter 16.

## 11 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to direct the Maine State Commission on the Arts and the Humanities to prepare a form contract that may be used by artists seeking to protect their works of art from alteration by persons or institutions acquiring the art work. The form contract is to be available to any interested persons, but is particularly to be used in the acquisition of art under the Percent for Art Act which directs the placement of art in state funded public buildings or facilities.
