1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment does the following:

3 1. It removes an unnecessary word;

4 2. It requires that the commission report back
5 to the Joint Standing Committee on Education;

6 3. It adds 2 members to the committee--one
7 school administrator and one Legislator; and

8 4. It increases the necessary quorum from 11 to
9 12 members.
