## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 111TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 592, L.D. 1710, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Establish County Budget Committees."

9 Amend the bill by striking out all of the Title 10 and inserting in its place the following:

11 'AN ACT to Provide a Referendum to Establish County 12 Budget Committees.'

13 Further amend the bill by striking out all of 14 section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

15 'Sec. 8. Statutory referendum procedure; submis-16 sion at statewide election; form of question; effec-17 tive date. This Act shall be submitted to the legal 18 voters of the State of Maine at a statewide election 19 to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday 20 of November following passage of this Act. The city 21 aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of 22 this State shall notify the inhabitants of their 23 respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in 24 the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide 25 election, to vote on the acceptance or rejection of 26 this Act by voting on the following question:

27 "Shall a county budget committee elected or 28 appointed by municipal officials be established?"

city, 29 The legal voters of each town and 30 plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and 31 shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received 32 33 counted and declared in open ward, town and 34 sorted, 35 plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary 36 of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. returns and, if it appears that a majority of the
legal votes are in favor of the Act, the Governor
shall proclaim that fact without delay, and the Act
shall become effective January 1, 1985.

5 The Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish 6 to each city, town and plantation all ballots, 7 returns and copies of this Act necessary to carry out 8 the purpose of this referendum.'

10 The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a 11 referendum on the bill.
