In order to assess a county tax, county commis-sioners, at least 60 days prior to the end of the county's fiscal year, shall prepare estimates of the 23 24 25 sums necessary to defray the expenses which have ac-crued or may probably accrue for the coming year, including salaries of the county officers and employ-ees, the building and repairing of jails, courthouses and appurtenances with the debts ared by their 26 27 28 29 30 and appurtenances, with the debts owed by their coun-31 ties. 32 The estimates shall be drawn so as to authorize 33 the appropriations to be made to each department or

agency of the county government for the year. The
 estimates shall provide specific amounts for personal
 services, contractual services, commodities, debt
 service and capital expenditures. These estimates
 shall be made on such forms and in such manner as
 shall be approved by the Department of Audit.

Copies of the forms shall be transmitted to the
county commissioners of each county by the office of
the Secretary of State 4 months prior to the end of a
county's fiscal year.

Prior to the convening of the budget committee, county commissioners of each county shall 11 12 the finalize estimates for the year. The county commis-sioners shall also show the county budget committee 13 14 15 any assessment for services to be provided to unorganized territories under Title 36, section 1603, 16 17 subsection 1, paragraph C. These assessments shall be 18 provided to the budget committee, prior to being submitted to the State Tax Assessor, in a form that 19 20 shows how the funds are to be spent on the unorgan-21 ized territories and any current balance of unorganized territory funds held by the county. 22

23 Whenever any specific appropriation of a depart-24 ment or agency of county government shall prove 25 insufficient to pay the required expenditures for 26 which that appropriation was made, the county commis-27 sioners may, upon written request of that department or agency, transfer from any other specific line 28 29 appropriation of the same department or agency an amount as required to meet the expenditure, provided 30 that the request shall bear the written approval of 31 the majority of the county commissioners. 32

33	There is established a contingent account in each
34	county in an amount not to exceed \$50,000. Such funds
35	as are available to each county may be used for this
36	purpose. This fund shall be used for emergency pur-
37	poses only at the discretion of the county commis-
38	sioners. At the end of each fiscal year, there shall

transferred from unencumbered county funds an amount sufficient to restore the established county 2 3 contingent account. 4 The county treasurer shall keep a record of any transfers between specific line categories or from the contingent account. 21 'Sec. 8. Referendum; submission at election; 22 form of question; effective date. This Act shall be 33 submitted to the legal voters of each county of this 34 State at an election to be held on the Tuesday fol-35 lowing the first Monday of November following passage 36 of this Act.

27 The county commissioners of each county are 28 authorized to expend such funds as are necessary to 29 implement the referendum.

30 The county clerk shall prepare the required bal-31 lots on which he shall state the subject matter of 32 this Act in the following question:

33 "Shall there be established for the County 34 of (name of county) a county budget committee

whose duties shall be to finally approve the .
 county budget?"

3 The voters shall indicate by a cross or check 4 mark against the words "Yes" or "No" the opinion of 5 the same.

6 Sections 2, 4, 6 and 9 of this Act shall take 7 effect upon the acceptance by a majority of the legal 8 voters in that county voting at that election; pro-9 vided the total number of votes cast for and against 10 the acceptance equals or exceeds 10% of the total 11 votes for all candidates for Governor cast in the 12 next previous gubernatorial election in that county.

13 The results of those elections shall be declared 14 by the board of commissioners of each county and due 15 certificates thereof filed by each county clerk with 16 the Secretary of State.

17 In any county which adopts a county budget com-18 mittee, the provisions of section 2 of this Act shall 19 take effect on January 1, 1984.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a

referendum on the adoption of county budget commit tees. The amendment would permit counties to adopt a
 budget committee format or to continue under the cur rent method of budget approval.
