7 SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1291, L.D. 1712,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Time for Acquiring those
9 Areas which have been Designated Potential
10 Passamaquoddy Indian Territory."

11 Amend the bill by striking out section 2 and
12 inserting in its place the following:

13 'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall not be
14 effective unless, within 60 days of the adjournment
15 of the Legislature, the Secretary of State receives
16 written certification by the Joint Tribal Council of
17 the Passamaquoddy Tribe that the tribe has agreed to
18 the provisions of this Act pursuant to the United
19 States Code, Title 25, Section 1725(e) (1), copies of
20 which shall be submitted by the Secretary of State to
21 the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the
22 House; provided that in no event may this Act become
23 effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
24 Legislature.'


STATEMENT OF FACT
