HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 595, L.D. 1717,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Statutes Relating to  
Fluoridation."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in that part design-  
ated "§2654." in subsection 2 by striking out all of  
the first underlined paragraph and inserting in its  
place the following:

'2. Multiple community water districts. In the  
case of a multiple community water district, authori-  
zation shall be by a majority vote of the legal  
voters voting in each municipality at a municipal  
election, as provided in section 2656, in the major-  
ity of the communities within the multiple community  
water district. A valid request for an election on  
whether or not to authorize the addition of fluoride  
may be made in either of the following ways.'

The purpose of this amendment is to require a  
majority vote in the majority of the affected commu-  
nities in order to authorize fluoridation in multiple  
community water districts.
