HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 595, L.D. 1717,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Statutes Relating to  
9 Fluoridation."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part design-  
ated "§2654." by striking out all of subsection 2  
and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Multiple community water districts. In the  
case of a multiple community water district, authori-  
zation shall be by a majority vote of:

A. All the legal voters voting in the district-  
wide election, as provided in section 2656; and

B. The legal voters voting in each municipality  
in a majority of the municipalities within the  
multiple community water district.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part  
designated "§2654." by adding after subsection 2 a  
new subsection 3 to read:

'3. Request for election. A valid request for  
an election on whether or not to authorize the addi-  
tion of fluoride may be made in either of the follow-  
ing ways.

A. A valid request for an election shall have  
been made when a majority of municipal officials,  
in a majority of municipalities within a multiple  
community water system district, vote to call an  
election. All such votes must be taken at least  
90 days before the general election. Each voting  
municipality shall certify within 5 days to all  
other municipalities within the public water sys-  
tem district the results of its vote.
