19 AN ACT to Identify Areas Requiring
20 Further Protection within the Allagash
21 Wilderness Waterway.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 **Sec. 1. Study.** The Joint Standing Committee on
26 Energy and Natural Resources shall study timber har-
27 vesting within the Allagash Wilderness Waterway and
28 identify specific areas that may require limited or
29 special harvesting methods because of their natural
30 character, habitat or other resources.

31 **Sec. 2. Consultation and assistance.** The com-
32 mittee shall consult with affected landowners for
33 this study. The Bureau of Parks and Recreation shall
34 provide assistance to the committee.

1 **Sec. 3. Report.** The committee shall submit its
2 report, including any proposed legislation, to the
3 Second Regular Session of the 111th Legislature.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 Timber harvesting is permitted in much of the
6 Allagash Wilderness Waterway. This bill requires the
7 Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural
8 Resources to study specific areas within the waterway
9 where cutting restrictions may be necessary and
10 appropriate.
