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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 598, L.D. 1721,
Bill, "AN ACT to Promote the Wise Use and Management
of Maine's Outstanding River Resources."

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Amend the bill by inserting after section 18 a
new section to read:

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'Sec. 19. 38 MRSA c. 6, as enacted by PL 1979,
c. 459, §1 and as amended by PL 1979, c. 663, §233,
is repealed.'

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Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

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Further amend the bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

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'Sec. 21. Effective date. Section 19 shall take
effect on July 1, 1984.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The Saco River Corridor Commission, established
in 1973, is currently the only river corridor commis-
sion in the State. After 10 years of experience, it
is now an appropriate time to review the functioning
of the commission. This amendment repeals the
present statutes creating the Saco River Corridor
Commission, but the effective date is delayed until
July 1, 1984. L.D. 1721 establishes a new procedure

1 for establishing and funding river corridor commis-
2 sions. The delayed effective date on this amendment
3 will allow the participating municipalities and the
4 Legislature to reassess the functioning of the com-
5 mission, and reestablish it if appropriate in accor-
6 dance with the provisions of the bill.
