21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	The Saco River Corridor Commission, established in 1973, is currently the only river corridor commission in the State. After 10 years of experience, it is now an appropriate time to review the functioning of the commission. This amendment repeals the present statutes creating the Saco River Corridor Commission, but the effective date is delayed until July 1, 1984. L.D. 1721 establishes a new procedure

- for establishing and funding river corridor commissions. The delayed effective date on this amendment will allow the participating municipalities and the Legislature to reassess the functioning of the commission, and reestablish it if appropriate in accordance with the provisions of the bill.
